


Weekly Parish Briefing Sunday 11 April 2021


I WONDER..... If you've been for a walk in Tutshill recently?

If so, you may well have noticed the many creations depicting Disney Films for the Scarecrow Trail. Most of us will have watched a Disney film at some point in our lives – even my Dad has seen one, and I can count the number of cinema visits we've made together on the fingers of one hand!









I **LOVE** a Disney film, and I think one of the reasons why is because they deal with timeless themes: Love and Loss, Death and Deception, Good and Evil, Sibling Relationships, Blended families, Sacrifice, and so much more. They cover in an accessible way the many experiences of life.

These stories are presented in an attractive, often musical, colourful way, featuring relatable characters; engaging children and the child in us all. But I think the best thing about a good children's film (by any production company!) is that it has an appeal for all ages. There is something for the children, the parents and even the grandparents.

Our worship gatherings need to have something for everyone... the young in years, the young in faith, the more mature in years and the mature in faith. Those who love colour, action and music, but also times of reflection and opportunities to go deeper with God.

Our worship is not based on a 'fairy story' but God's Story, The Greatest Story Ever Told. Found in the pages of His word, the Bible, which covers themes of Love and Loss, Death and Deception, Good and Evil, Fear and Courage, Sibling Relationships, Blended Families, Sacrifice, and so much more. What a privilege that God trusts us to share His story.

One of the most fulfilling parts of my role over the past year has been the introduction and development of **W**orship **W**ithout **W**alls. What a joy and privilege to meet as the whole family of God; all ages and stages of life and faith. Those who have been walking with Jesus for decades and those who are just beginning their journey of faith, as well as those who are exploring Christian faith for the first time.

I believe that the fullest expression of communal worship is found when the whole family of God is gathered. Deuteronomy 16 teaches God's people how to worship Him, "Be joyful in the LORD's presence, together with your children." (Verses 11, 13 Good News Bible) Yes, we need times to be adults together, to share and grow in faith; and children need times when they are away from their parents. This is where Life Groups, Youth Ministry and Splash are a vital part of our life as the church of God. I believe God loves intergenerational worship.

It was wonderful to gather outside last weekend to remember Christ's death and celebrate His resurrection: adults, children and even dogs! Plus thanks to technology this worship can be streamed into the homes of those who cannot be present physically.

I know that outdoor worship will not suit everyone, but as we journey forward together in the power and love of the Holy Spirit, why not come along to Tutshill on the first Sunday of the month and be part of the full family of God giving Him praise and worship amongst His glorious creation?

Annual Church Meeting, Parish of Tidenham with Beachley and Lancaut

A) The annual church meeting will be held in Tidenham church at 10.30 on Sunday 25 April after the morning service. Please book your place with Parish Administrator Clare if you wish to attend.

B) The agenda for the meeting is available on church notice boards and from Clare or Iain Gardiner.

- C) The Annual Accounts for 2020 have been approved by the PCC and signed off by the independent examiner. The Annual Accounts, along with the Trustees Report for 2020, are posted on church notice boards, but if people would like a personal hard copy or electronic copy they are available from Clare or lain Gardiner.
- D) If people would like a hard copy or electronic copy of the Annual Parish Report for 2020 they can be requested from Clare or Iain Gardiner who will send them out when available.
- E) This year there are vacancies for two churchwardens and four members of the PCC. Our current wardens Brian Duerden and Nicholette Flatman have both advised that they are willing to serve for another year, and PCC member Andy Palmer has advised that he is willing to serve another 3-year term. John-Ross Henderson, who was co-opted after the October 2020 annual meeting, and our Youth Co-ordinator, Ethan Richards have also submitted nomination forms for PCC membership. This does not preclude anyone putting their name forward as an enthusiastic alternative! Nomination forms are available at the back of our churches from 04 April and from Iain Gardiner: -
- the person who is nominated should send me the nomination form showing who has nominated him / her and confirming that they comply with the conditions on the form and are willing to stand and
- the proposer and seconder should email me to confirm that they are indeed proposing and seconding the named individual.
