On Church Family.

Jesus said, "I am the vine, you are the branches." "Remain in me and I in you." It is to be assumed from Jesus' teaching here and elsewhere that the connection(s) we have to one another as a church family has an impact on our relationship to the Lord, and our individual relationship with the Lord has an impact on our relationships with one another. The connections of the branches to each other through the vine are a fundamental part of our life in God.
