**The Collect** Advent 4: God our redeemer, who prepared the Blessed Virgin Mary to be the mother of your Son: grant that, as she looked for his coming as our Saviour, so we may be ready to greet him when he comes again as our judge; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

**Post Communion** prayer: Heavenly Father, who chose the Blessed Virgin Mary to be the mother of the promised Saviour: fill us your servants with your grace, that in all things we may embrace your holy will and with her rejoice in your salvation; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

'My children now drink milk and their weight has increased. They are healthier because they have food,' she says. '[Before] sometimes what we earned was enough for only one meal a day. But my son told me this morning that he was very grateful to God and to you for the help you are giving us.'
