



This weekend we will have a new deacon and a new priest in the parishes with the ordination of Nicki Bullivant to the diaconate on Saturday 19th September and the ordination of David Rees to the priesthood on Sunday 20th September. Congratulations to both of them as they finally begin their new roles. In total there are 14 new deacons and 10 new priests being ordained this weekend in Gloucester Cathedral. Back at St Luke's as well as Tidenham

Last week saw a successful resumption of worship at St Luke's Tutshill with a Covid service time of 11am. This was alongside St Mary & St Peter's, Tidenham service of Holy Communion at 9.30am Covid time! Both services are adhering fully to Government guidelines with a 2-metre distance between worshippers and the wearing of a face coverings by all (except when someone has to lead). It is great to be able to offer a little more capacity for meeting for Sunday worship. If you would like to attend please do contact Clare to book a place. Financial Support during this time

For many years Woodcroft Christian Centre has played a special part in the life of the Parish of Tidenham, the life of the church in many parts of the UK and the lives of lots and lots of young people. However, Coronavirus has meant no visitors and little income for the Centre for over 6 months now. The Centre has made a financial appeal, for 100 people to give £50 a month for 12 months in order to keep the Centre up and running and take it beyond Covid 19 restrictions to the place of bookings and offering their ministry once again. The PCC (the church here) through our commitment to giving have committed to being one of those donors and invites others to hear this appeal and respond too.

There are also other charities at home and abroad in need of financial support, including our own church here in the Parish. Some people are facing greater challenges with their personal finances and will be unable to give as they once did. Others amongst us have the financial capacity to give. The impact on society of charities and churches not being funded will be significant and therefore the need for good old-fashioned Christian giving with tithes and offerings is needed more than ever! May we hear that call!
