Trusting God

One of the features of being a Christian, whether in ordained ministry or not, is trusting God in and through life. There are times when that's fairly easy, such as when God has been good to us and we are overwhelmed by his love and blessings, and we know his presence. Yet there are other times, aren't there? Hard times (e.g. during Covid). Times when his presence seems absent. Times when difficult decisions have to be made and the way forward isn't obvious. Or, times when we sense God calling us to do something that feels way out of our comfort zone. The psalmist knew something of trusting in God's love and goodness: *"When I am afraid, I put my trust in you"* (Psalm 56:3). And, *"Those who know your name trust in you, for you, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek you"* (Psalm 9:10). The book of Proverbs says, *"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways honour him and he will direct your paths."* Proverbs 3:5 Corrie Ten Boom says, *"Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to a known God."* May we find the courage to put our trust in the Lord!

He has been fantastically loyal and dedicated servant to God and the Parish of Tidenham, very often working behind the scenes without any recognition. Woodcroft Christian Centre Appeal

For many years Woodcroft Christian Centre has played a special part in the life of the Parish of Tidenham, the life of the church in many parts of the UK and the lives of lots and lots of young people. However, Coronavirus has meant no visitors and little income for the Centre for over 6 months now. The Centre has made a financial appeal, for 100 people to give £50 a month for 12 months in order to keep the Centre up and running and take it beyond Covid 19 restrictions to the place of bookings and offering their ministry once again. The PCC (the church here) through our commitment to giving have committed to being one of those donors and we invite others to hear this appeal and respond too.

As reported last week there are also other charities at home and abroad in need of financial support, including our own church here in the Parish. Some people are facing greater challenges with their personal finances and will be unable to give as they once did. Others amongst us have the financial capacity to give. The impact on society of charities and churches not being funded will be significant and therefore the need for good old-fashioned Christian giving with tithes and offerings is needed more than ever! May we hear that call!
