Baptism and Confirmation

Bereaved families will be invited to the annual All Souls Service, when loved ones are remembered, candles lit in their memory, and all are prayed for.

Revd Nicki Bullivant is developing projects such as targeted courses, Pilates in Church and Bereavement Support to help people in our parish. She works closely with Sedbury Space, our thriving community hub and we hold regular Parish Coffee Mornings and Parish Lunches.

The Aim is to promote human flourishing - social, physical, psychological and spiritual - seeing faith as part of the wellbeing of the whole person.

The Beneficiaries are parents, youth and children and those overlooked in communities or affected by rural isolation.

The Objectives are to facilitate Post Covid recovery for individuals, church and community; to nurture faith, giving individuals a sense of belonging, vocation, wholeness and well-being; to develop St Luke's reordered space as a resource hub for well-being within the Parish and wider Deanery.

1. Please notify the PCC's Gift Aid officer if you:

 - Change your name or home address
 - No longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/ or capital gains. Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which currently allows charities to reclaim 25 pence for every £1 donated.
2. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax.
