ANNUAL CHURCH MEETING / ANNUAL REVISION OF CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL - Tidenham Parish, Iain Gardiner, Church Electoral Roll Officer 01291 624868.

This year's Annual Church Meeting (APCM /AGM) will be held at 12:00 noon in St Luke's Church, Tutshill, on Sunday 23rd April, i.e. after the Morning Service, followed by a Bring & Share lunch.

In advance of that meeting, the PCC must review the existing Church Electoral Roll which has been posted on all Church notice boards, between Sunday 19th March and Sunday 2nd April. If your name is already on the Roll, you don't need to do anything! If your name is **not** on the Church Electoral Roll and you wish to register, application forms are available at the back of each church, or email me at iain706gardiner@btinternet.com. These should be completed and returned to me either electronically or via hard copy no later than Sunday 2nd April.

The formal legal notice of the proposed annual revision to the roll and Tidenham Parish's GDPR privacy notice redated January 2023 have also been posted on the church notice boards.
