## ANNUAL CHURCH MEETINGS SUNDAY 11 MAY / OUR NEW CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

Our Annual Church Meetings (Annual Meeting of Parishioners and APCM) will be held at 12:00 noon in St Luke's Church Tutshill on Sunday 11 May, after the usual church service. The Draft Minutes of last year's meetings have been on church notice boards for some time, or you can ask Annabelle or lain for a copy.

This is the opportunity for our church community to elect two churchwardens for the next 12 months and one third of our Parochial Church Council (PCC) members for the next 3 years. Our current churchwardens Brian Duerden and Robin Riordan have both advised that they are willing to stand for another year. There are expected to be six vacancies for the PCC this year, and Paul Coombs has indicated that he is willing to stand for another 3-year term.
