ROAD CLOSURE – IMPACT ON ST LUKE TUTSHILL

Sunday Services are not affected, whilst road works are being carried out on the B4228 Coleford Road in Tutshill from 28 July–21 August 0900-1500 weekdays only. However:

- Wednesday's noon Healing Eucharist will be held at St Mary & St Peter Tidenham 1200
- Tuesday's Pilates will be cancelled until September
- No Coffee Morning in August

Stewardship and Funding Church Activities

As with all our domestic situations, the costs of sustaining our church ministry and associated parish activities are rising inexorably! There may be a view that during our vacancy without a vicar's stipend to pay, our outgoings may be reduced, BUT this has no impact on our PCC finances because the stipend is paid from "central" funds not directly by the PCC. We are still expected to pay our parish share to the diocese, but the PCC has reduced the amount of this significantly this year to help maintain our general activities and outgoings. We know that times are not easy, financially, for many people, but we would encourage those of you who feel able to look at what you can contribute through the collections (cash or card) or standing orders to the maintenance of Christ's Ministry and the spread of the Gospel in our parish.
