PARISH NEWS & INFORMATION

New Parish Electoral Roll 2025

Every C of E Parish has to create a completely new Church Electoral Roll in time for the 2025 Annual church meeting. The roll acts as a "membership list" for churchgoers in the parish and gives entitlement to vote at the Annual Parochial Council Meeting (APCM) or stand for office as Churchwarden or PCC / Deanery Synod member.

Church rules require a formal notice to be published in early February, and you can see this on our church Notice Boards. Over the next few weeks congregations at Sunday services will be informed of what they need to do, but they can always contact the Church Electoral Roll Officer Iain Gardiner for more information.

- We start the new roll from scratch, meaning that everyone who wishes to be on the new roll needs to fill in a hard copy or pdf application form.
- Electoral Roll application forms are available at each church and should be returned to lain Gardiner by 15 April.
- The preparation of the new roll will be completed by 22 April and exhibited in churches for at least two weeks before the APCM on Sunday 11 May 2025.

If you have previously given lain your email address, he will send you a fillable pdf file that you can complete and email back to him at <u>iain706gardiner@btinternet.com</u>. If, however, you were on the Parish Electoral Roll, you will **not** automatically be included in the next one; it is each person's responsibility to 'sign up' again, if they wish to be on the Parish Electoral Roll.

LATEST UPDATE – THE VACANCY FOR OUR VICAR

We had hoped to be able to start our announcements this week with news that our three sets of PCC representatives would be starting the shortlisting and interview process for the appointment of a new Vicar of Tidenham Parish and Priest in Charge of the Parishes of St Briavels and Hewelsfield.

Unfortunately, our initial advertisements did not yield any applications by the closing date of February 10th. However, this is not a disaster and is by no means unusual at this time in the Church of England! We had a Zoom meeting with Archdeacon Hilary and colleagues from our parishes, and the Diocese believes we have a very strong parish profile and is keen to re-advertise the post at an early date. We

discussed the most suitable time which will be sooner rather than later; there is a minimum gap of eight weeks and as that takes us to Holy Week and Easter (not a good time to advertise!) so we are probably looking at early May. A timetable will be set out for the period of advertising, closing date, shortlisting and interviews. An early May advertisement could still see us have a new incumbent by late September, so some time would be caught up on our original expectations.

Meanwhile, the details of the post will remain "open" on various websites and any enquiries will be treated positively and could or may lead directly to applications being considered at any stage. Church networks will also be used to continue to seek potential interest.

Clearly, this initial lack of response is disappointing but there are numerous other parishes that have had to go through more than one advertising round before successfully attracting the person they are seeking – so, we must not be downhearted! Please continue to pray for a successful outcome; in the meantime please contact Revd Nicki for pastoral and Churchwardens, Brian or Robin, for non-pastoral matters. And we also have a special prayer to help us with the vacancy:

Heavenly Father, during this vacancy, guard and grow the Parishes of Tidenham, St Briavels and Hewelsfield, as we serve you together in this period without a Priest in Charge.

Lord Jesus, we know you have plans for us and that these plans are good. We ask you now that You will help us to share responsibility, grow in faith, love one another, care for those in need, reach out to others, and welcome newcomers.

Holy Spirit, please guide those who are seeking the right person for us, and those who are seeking the right place for their ministry, that together we may discover Your way for the future and see Your Kingdom grow.

All this we ask in the strength of the Holy Trinity. Amen.
