SAFEGUARDING AUDIT - The Church of England has asked iNEQE Safeguarding Group to carry out Safeguarding Audits to make sure that dioceses and cathedrals are doing all they can to create environments where everyone feels safe, valued and respected.

The Diocese of Gloucester is one of the first few dioceses and cathedrals working with the new national safeguarding audit process with the iNEQE. As part of this audit, the process offers a range of opportunities to engage directly with iNEQE, to participate in a survey and give feedback.
