ANNUAL CHURCH MEETING / ANNUAL REVISION OF CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL – Tidenham Parish, Iain Gardiner, Church Electoral Roll Officer 01291 624868.

This year's Annual Church Meeting (APCM /AGM) will be held at 12:00 noon in St Luke's Church, Tutshill, on Sunday 23rd April, i.e. after the Morning Service, followed by a Bring & Share lunch.

In advance of that meeting, the PCC must review the existing Church Electoral Roll which has been posted on all Church notice boards, between Sunday 19th March and Sunday 2nd April. If your name is already on the Roll, you don't need to do anything! If your name is not on the Church Electoral Roll and you wish to register, application forms are available at the back of each church or email to iain706gardiner@btinternet.com. These should be completed and returned either electronically or via hard copy no later than **TODAY Sunday 2nd April**.

This year there are vacancies for two churchwardens and three members of Forest South Deanery Synod and seven members of the PCC. Existing PCC members Robin Riordan and Iain Gardiner have advised that they are willing to serve another 3-year term. Nomination forms are available at the back of our churches and from the PCC Secretary Iain Gardiner: -

- the person who is nominated should send Iain the nomination form showing who has nominated him / her and confirming that they comply with the conditions on the form and are willing to stand and
- the proposer and seconder should email lain to confirm that they are indeed proposing and seconding the named individual.
