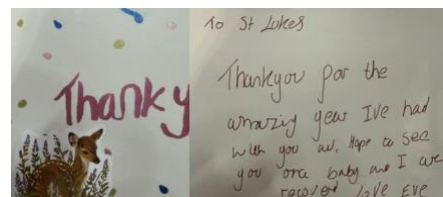


Full Immersion Baptism x 3

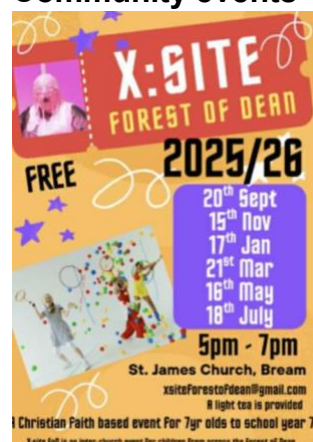
Five Churches Fellowship – 29 September and 24 November.
