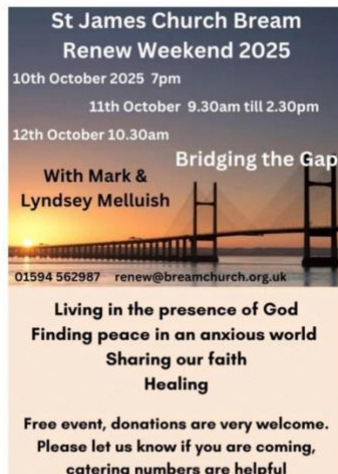
### **Tidenham parish Quiet Day at St Luke's Church, Tutshill**
